



Welcome to the Certificate of Practical Nursing Program

Congratulations to your acceptance to the nursing program! The following information is important for a smooth transition into the program in the fall semester. Instruction will be primarily in-person, and synchronous in nature, including clinical rotations.

We will be holding an in-person orientation to review information about the Practical Nursing (PN) Program, required actions, and your responsibilities as you prepare for school to start in August. Prior to attending the in-person orientation, please watch the recorded PowerPoint that provides an overview of this information. You may access the PowerPoint via your Slate account. An invitation to the orientation will be emailed to all accepted and confirmed PN students. As part of the orientation, you will be taking a standardized Kaplan exam that includes basic content related to Math, English (reading and writing), and Sciences. Please know that the exam results will not impact your acceptance in the program.

Your scrub uniform for this school year consists of a hunter green top with white pants and shoes and an NCCC patch (sewn to the left sleeve – see handbook). ➤ **Health and Professional Requirements**

To protect the health of all North Country Community College (NCCC) members and the patients you serve, NCCC and our clinical partners require students to fulfill certain health requirements. All nurse students are expected to submit their health records and professional requirements to the NCCC Nursing Program at the address below. Failure to submit the materials listed below in the specified timeframe will result in your acceptance to the nursing program being rescinded.

Immunizations and Professional Requirements

➤ The vaccines below are to be reported by your physician on the **Student Immunization Record Form** found at nccc.edu/nursing/

REQUIRED:

1. MMR vaccine (required) given twice (two doses)

OR

2. Measles (Rubeola) (required in the absence of MMR). Two doses or immune titer is acceptable in lieu of the vaccine. Attach a copy of the immune titer report **or** a copy of vaccine record.
3. Mumps (required in the absence of MMR) one dose or immune titer is acceptable in lieu of the vaccine. Attach a copy of immune titer report or copy of vaccine record.
4. Rubella (German measles) (required in the absence of MMR). One dose. Please attach a copy of the immune titer report or copy of vaccine record.
5. Covid (required). Two doses of Moderna or Pfizer, or one dose of J&J. A booster is also required for all students.

➤ Varicella vaccine (required). Two doses: Attach a medical document with the dates of the vaccines **or** attach a copy of the immune titer report. Complete and submit Varicella (Chicken Pox) and Zoster (Shingles) form (attached).

➤ Influenza vaccine (required; annual each Fall Semester)

Students who have a medical exemption, must have their provider complete the Department of Health Medical Exemption Statement and will be required to wear a mask in all patient care areas.

➤ Meningococcal vaccine (recommended but not required). One dose within the last five years. You must fill out and submit the Student Immunization Record Form indicating the date of the vaccine or your decision to waive the vaccine.

➤ Hepatitis B vaccine (recommended but not required). Three doses: Attach a medical document with the dates of the vaccines **or** attach a copy of the immune titer report.

➤ Physical Examination Must be a current Physical

- ❖ See the attached form which includes history, proof of Tetanus and Pertussis vaccine. (i.e., Tdap within the last ten years) and 2-part PPD status. PPD (PPD/Mantoux/TB Tine) due yearly.
- ❖ OSHA Fit Test Medical Clearance form. Required should students need to be fit tested to utilize an N-95 mask during clinical.
- ❖ Two Step PPD
 - 2 PPDs with negative reading are required within one year.
 - If this is your first PPD you are required to complete a two-step exam. One exam with a negative reading and a retest in 1-3 weeks
 - If you have had a PPD within the year, please provide a copy along with your updated PPD.

Any positive PPD/allergic reaction requires a negative chest x-ray. The chest x-ray is required every 2 years or Quantiferon Gold blood test yearly.

➤ **CPR Requirements for Nursing Students**

All practical nurse and registered nurse students must have a current CPR certification. **Failure to maintain current certification may result in loss of scheduled clinical experience.**

The only accepted courses are:

American Heart Association: BLS for the Healthcare Provider

Red Cross: CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer and Healthcare Provider

➤ **Student Professional Liability Insurance**

All students admitted to the Nursing Programs are **required** to provide proof of student nurse professional liability insurance in the amounts of **\$1,000,000.00 for each claim and \$6,000,000.00 aggregate** and maintain coverage for the length of the program.

One affordable option for professional liability insurance is the Nurses Service Organization. Please contact NSO at www.nso.com. Once purchased, provide a copy of the **Certificate of Insurance** (an email with the certificate will be sent 24 hours after payment) **not proof of payment please**. When applying for liability insurance be certain to request insurance coverage as a first year Practical Nurse student. If you are under the age of 18, you will need to request a paper application to process.

➤ **Technology Requirements**

All students will be required to have minimum system specifications.
