At the completion of this degree program, students will be able to do the following:

- 1. Identify and describe the major areas of human services and child and family services practice, including the main features of each area, the settings where they operate and the services they offer society, both nationally and locally.
- 2. Identify, explain and apply the foundational knowledge, theories, models and methods that guide human services and child and family services practice.
- 3. Identify, describe and demonstrate application of the foundational skills and competencies expected of child and family services workers.
- 4. Identify and discuss the core values that serve as the foundation for human services work.
- 5. Identify and discuss the ethical principles that guide child and family services practice, the critical ethical issues that confront child and family services workers, and the appropriate means of responding, including ethical decision-making.
