

## **AS Wilderness Recreation Leadership**

## At the completion of this degree program, students will be able to do the following:

- 1. Students will be able to identify and articulate a code of ethics as related to the field of outdoor recreation and make professional and personal decisions based on this ethical framework.
- 2. Students will be able to articulate how the outdoor recreation subspecialty fits into the larger discipline of recreation.
- 3. Students will be able to apply management concepts in an outdoor recreation context.
- 4. Students will be able to demonstrate awareness of legal issues that affect the outdoor recreation industry such as liability, negligence, use of waivers and assumption of risk forms.
- 5. Students will be able to consider environmental and social issues when making decisions related to outdoor recreation programming.
- 6. Students will be able to apply and maintain a working knowledge of environmental science topics and incorporate these topics into outdoor recreation programming.
- 7. Students will be able to articulate a personal philosophy regarding wilderness and understand current wilderness issues & management techniques.
- 8. Students will be able to understand the experiential education process and plan & implement effective experiential lessons.
