



COVID-19 UPDATE

October 26, 2021

SUMMARY:

The North Country's positivity rate has dropped but it's still the highest (4.8 %) in the state, slightly ahead of Western NY (4.5%) and the Finger Lakes (4.4%).

IF YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS:

If you have Covid-19 symptoms, do not come to campus, and please contact your health care provider.

What are the symptoms? Fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea.

BOOSTER SHOT UPDATE:

There are now booster recommendations for all three COVID-19 vaccines available in the United States.

The CDC and NYS Dept. of Health recommend that certain individuals who received a Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine at least six months after their initial series get their "booster dose." These individuals include those 65 years and older and people who are 18 and older who live in long-term care settings, have underlying medical conditions, or work or live in high-risk settings.

Additionally, booster doses are recommended for all individuals 18 and older who received the Janssen/Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine at least two months ago.


