Clinical/Field Internship: We will be following the NRAEMT Clinical and field guidelines which are due to be updated January of 2024. Currently -There will be a minimum 24-hour hospital-based emergency room rotation (with possible addition of Pre op time for IV skills based on skill level), 6-hour Operating Room airway placement observation shift and a minimum 60-hour ambulance field internship during the second half of the course. We will be using FISDAP via Jones Bartlet LMS for Hours and Skills tracking. <u>A separate hospital orientation, a 2</u> hour OR orientation, and health requirements as set by the hospital need to be completed prior to any hospital clinicals. Field internship letters will be sent when cleared for field internship time. Will include allowed skills.
