Clinical/Field Internship: We will be following the NRAEMT Clinical and field guidelines which were updated July 2024. There will be a minimum 24-hour hospital-based emergency room rotation (with possible addition of Pre op time for IV skills based on skill level), 6-hour Operating Room airway placement observation shift and a minimum 60-hour ambulance field internship during the second half of the course.

We will be using FISDAP via Jones Bartlet LMS for Hours and Skills tracking. <u>A separate hospital orientation</u>, <u>a 2 hour OR orientation</u>, <u>and health requirements as set by the hospital need to be completed prior to any hospital clinicals</u>. Field internship letters will be sent when cleared for field internship time. Will include allowed skills.
