**Articulation Agreement  
St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES  
and  
North Country Community College**

The intent of this articulation agreement is to foster an ongoing relationship between North Country Community College and St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES which will enable both institutions to meet the needs of their students. This agreement will prevent unnecessary duplication of instruction and will allow the student from St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES who attends North Country Community College to receive transfer credit for coursework taken as a part of the *Criminal Justice* curriculum at St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES.

After evaluation of course outlines and requirements within the *St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES Criminal Justice* program, North Country Community College agrees to award transfer credits to students who have completed the *St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES Criminal Justice* program and are admitted to North Country Community College for the following courses:




The process for the student wishing to receive transfer credits is as follows:

1. Notify the North Country Community College Admissions representative of their intent to attend the College and request that the transfer credit be granted.
2. Request that a letter of reference from the instructor be forwarded to the Admissions Office on the Saranac Lake Campus indicating that the student achieved a grade of B (80%) or higher and his/her achievement level was collegiate in nature. (Admissions, North Country Community College, PO Box 89, 23 Santanoni Avenue, Saranac Lake, NY 12983).

The articulation agreement may be reviewed at the request of either party and contains no expiration date. Each party is responsible for notification of programmatic changes when they occur.

All other enrollment eligibility requirements must be met by incoming students in a timely fashion. This agreement does not guarantee enrollment. The full requirements for admission are published in the NCCC catalog – [www.nccc.edu](http://www.nccc.edu).
