

2025-2026 UNUSUAL ENROLLMENT HISTORY FORM

INSTRUCTIONS:

Your financial aid application (FAFSA) has been selected for a review process called “Unusual Enrollment History.” To complete this review, you will need to supply the Financial Aid Office with academic transcripts from the institutions listed below. Unofficial copies are acceptable. You must supply the Financial Aid Office with these transcripts, whether you completed credits at the institution or not. **The Unusual Enrollment History review cannot be completed until all requested transcripts are received and reviewed.**

The U.S. Department of Education established regulations to prevent fraud and abuse in the Federal Student Aid program by identifying students with unusual enrollment histories. Some students who have an unusual enrollment history have legitimate reasons for their enrollment at multiple institutions. However, such an enrollment history requires our office to review your file to determine future federal financial aid eligibility. If selected by the Department of Education, this must be resolved before you will receive financial aid.

Definition of Unusual Enrollment History

The specific pattern the Department of Education uses to select students includes those students who have received a Federal Pell Grant and/or Federal Direct Subsidized/Unsubsidized loan at multiple institutions during the past four academic years. Once the Department of Education indicates that a student has an unusual enrollment history, the Financial Aid office must then act and review the academic history prior to determining federal financial aid eligibility for that student.

We will check your financial aid history at all previous institutions that you attended during the last four financial aid years. You are required to have received academic credit at any institution you received the federal Pell grant or Federal Direct Subsidized/Unsubsidized loan while attending in those relevant academic years.
