Essential Duties and Requirements:

Processing students into the dining hall utilizing the presented meal card. Ringing up cash and credit card customers on the Point-of-Sale system. Serving students food for lunch and dinner service. Plating desserts; presenting desserts on food trays. Stocking the salad bar and refilling as necessary during the meal period. Properly cleaning and sanitizing food items for the salad bar. Wiping down cafeteria tables; sweeping and light mopping of the dining hall. Refilling ice bins.

Must be capable of lifting at least 35 lbs. Use of professionally sharpened knives is also required.

Position is paid on an hourly basis. Starting rate is a minimum of \$16/hour and is dependent on level of experience.
