College Scholarship Guideline

1. The St. Joseph's College Scholarship is designed to provide college financial assistance to an adult student (21 years of age or older) returning to school after an absence, and enrolled in a degree program in addiction studies or related field.

2. The student must be a New York State resident and have been accepted at an accredited college or university. Members of the Selection Committee and their families will not be eligible for the award.

3. One scholarship per year will be available beginning in 1997 based upon funds available. The scholarship may be withheld based on lack of funds or lack of an acceptable candidate.

4. An application will consist of:
 - a. A completed application form with requested attachments
 - b. Verification of enrollment in a degree program
 - c. Commitment to a personal interview if necessary to select finalist

5. Applications must be received by the Selection Committee by May 1st.

6. All applications will be reviewed by the St. Joseph's Scholarship Selection Committee. The committee's decision will be final and will be communicated to all applicants by June 30.
